First Year B. Pharm

In order to secure admission to **First year of Four year Degree course** in Pharmacy, candidate should have -

- Passed the HSC (Std. XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics &/or Biology and secured minimum 50% marks for **Open Category** while 45% marks for **Reserved Category** candidates belonging to Maharashtra state or its equivalent examination.
- Qualified in **KIMS Pharmacy Entrance Exam** for Pharmacy Degree Course conducted by the Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences Deemed University. Maximum marks from amongst Mathematics and Biology will be considered in case the Candidate appears for Mathematics as well as Biology subject of KIMS CET.

Direct Second Year B. Pharm (Lateral Entry)

- In order to secure admission to **DIRECT SECOND YEAR** in B. Pharmacy, the candidate should have passed D. Pharm. of MSBTE or equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks **IN SINGLE SEATING** from PCI approved institute. The admission of such candidate shall be subject to the approval from the concerned authority.
