

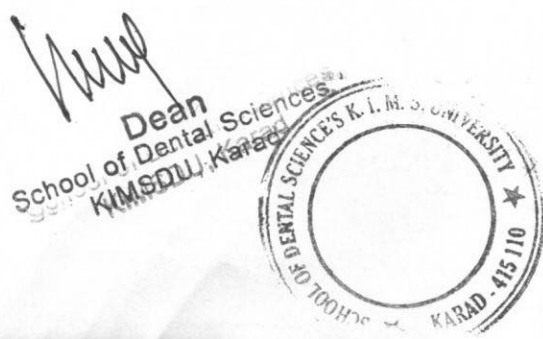

Event plan/ report:

The behaviors of the dentist and dental staff members are the primary tools used to guide the behavior of the pediatric patient. The dentist's attitude, body language, and communication skills are critical to creating a positive dental visit for the child and to gain trust from the child and parent. Dentist/ staff behaviors that help reduce anxiety and encourage patient cooperation are giving clear and specific instructions, an empathetic communication style, and an appropriate level of physical contact accompanied by verbal reassurance. With this idea, School of Dental sciences took an initiative to invite one of their alumni active in this field, Dr Apurva Pisal to share her knowledge on the subject.

A total of 98 delegates were present that included undergraduates, interns and staff of School of Dental Sciences. The speakers shared her expertise on the topic. Dr Apurva spoke on Communicating with children poses special challenges for the dentist and the dental team. She spoke on how various techniques must be integrated into an overall behavior guidance approach individualized for each child.

Pre and post tests forms were circulated as Google forms to promote paperless documentation before and after the session. A positive outcome was achieved with a pre test average score of 20% and post test average score of 75%. An *Average Learning Gain (ALG)* of 45% was achieved. He explained in his speech that, Basic registration criteria in Maldivian nurses are required to submit Certified copies of the following documents with the originals, National I/D card, Undergraduate and Postgraduate nursing qualifications as applicable, Marks and transcript of the nursing program completed & Certificates of registration with other nursing licensing authorities (if applicable). The Maldives Nursing and Midwifery Council may also request the nurse to submit any other documents for evaluation of his/her application official need to obtain temporary registration for the required duration from MNMC. Registration fees and duration for the process of pre-registration and registration will be published regularly. All expatriate who fulfill the various categories of MNMC will be granted temporary registration of 2 years and also according to the duration of their employment contracts. He also said that nurses are required to renew the practicing license every 2 years.

He said registered nurses (RN) work for hospitals or medical clinics. They may also work for other organizations, such as outpatient facilities, rehabilitation centers, or senior centers. Their main job is to promote wellness and health.

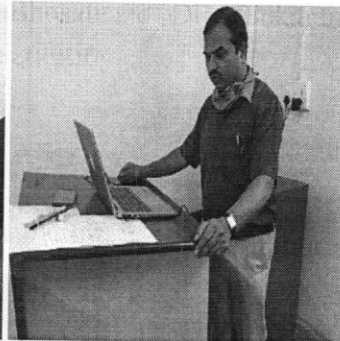
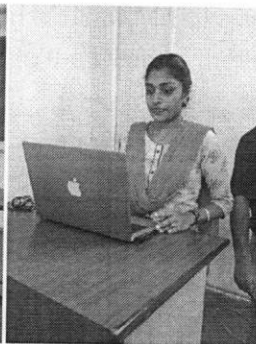
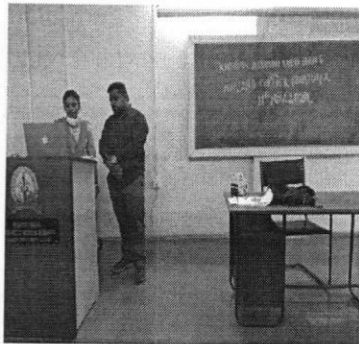
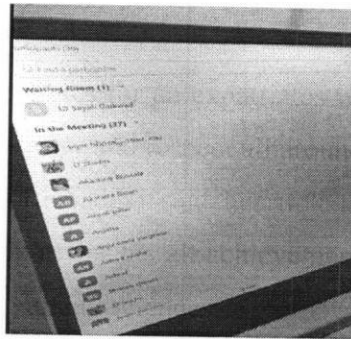
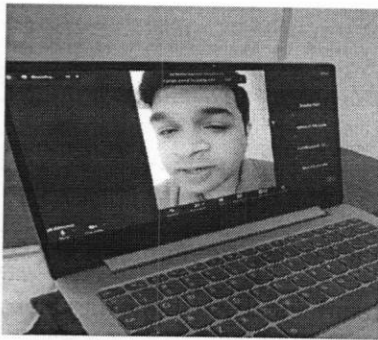
