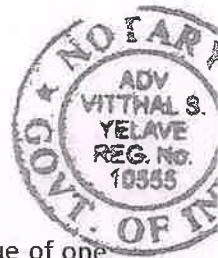

- n. In case of violation of any of the agreed conditions of the MOU by either side, issue of one month advance notice, by either party, is sufficient for terminating their respective obligations under this MOU. However before discontinuation, both the parties may discuss and try to resolve the violation pointed out by either party. All disputes to this understanding are subject to the Jurisdiction of the courts in Karad.
- o. The duration and binding force of this MOU shall be for a minimum period of 3 years from 1st August 2019 to 31st July 2022.

- d. KHA will not accept any Chlorinated waste or any waste subjected to any type of Radiation.
- e. It is made clear to the Hospital that No Untreated Bio-Medical Waste should be kept stored beyond a period of 48 hours.
- f. The rates for the service of collection, disposal of bio-medical wastes shall be decided by both parties amicably. KHA shall prepare a bill in the beginning of next month for the previous month and should submit the bill before 10th of next month. Within 7 working days from the date of receipt of the bill, Krishna Hospital shall make the payment to KHA.
- g. KHA will charge a price of Rs. 50/- per kilogram as agreed with Krishna Hospital for collection, transportation, treatment and final disposal of Biomedical waste. This price will be Valid for minimum 3 years. The transportation charges amounting to Rs. 1,500/- per month shall be paid separately
- h. All payments shall be made by cheque or Bank transfer. No cash payment shall be accepted in any case. KHA is not responsible for any cash payments and also will recover bank charges, in the event of dishonor of cheque.
- i. In case of non-receipt of payment on the agreed date from KRISHNA HOSPITAL, KHA will stop the collection of waste with 15 days prior notice to Krishna Hospital and under intimation to MPCB.
- j. KHA will collect Bio-medical waste regularly and dispose off the same as per existing rules and regulations and those may be prescribed in future by the government authorities. KHA will issue Annual Certificate about Bio-medical waste received from KRISHNA HOSPITAL.
- k. KHA will issue proof of waste collection from KRISHNA HOSPITAL on regular basis. This will facilitate the Krishna Hospital in obtaining the requisite compliance as per Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016 (The same has to be mentioned in the Authorization Form).
- l. KRISHNA HOSPITAL shall have right to inform any irregularity in collection of bio-medical waste to KHA for immediate action under intimation to MPCB.
- m. This Memorandum of understanding is entered into on the express understanding that M/s. Karad Hospital Association, Karad will maintain and run the facility of collecting, transporting, treating & disposing of the bio-medical waste at their plant strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and it shall be their responsibility to obtain the consent from MPCB or any other designated authority and shall keep the same always valid.

WHEREAS M/s. Karad Hospital Association, Karad has been appointed by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as MPCB) vide Consent agreement dated 6th December 2018 as "The Operator" for the purposes of treatment & disposal of "Bio-medical Waste" for Karad Municipal Council and adjoining area.

AND WHEREAS Krishna Hospital is engaged in the activity of providing medical, clinical and surgical treatments/care to its patients at its hospital situated at Malakapur, Karad.

AND WHEREAS Krishna Hospital is required to segregate and dispose of the bio-medical waste generated at its hospital in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed by the government authority.

AND WHEREAS KHA expressed its willingness to perform the activity of collecting, transporting and disposing of the bio-medical waste generated at Krishna Hospital in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed under Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 & Bio Medical Waste Management (Amendment) Rules 2018.

AND WHEREAS KHA and Krishna Hospital after series of discussions and meetings have arrived at a mutual agreement pertaining to disposal of bio-medical waste generated at the Krishna Hospital on the following terms & conditions

AND WHEREAS both the parties further decided that Krishna Hospital shall become a member of KHA for disposal of bio-medical waste with limited liabilities as per the terms and conditions of this agreement.

NOW IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES as under

- a. KRISHNA HOSPITAL has to segregate and give its bio-medical waste, properly packed in color-coded bags as per Schedule I given in Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 & Bio Medical Waste Management (Amendment) Rules 2018 for treatment and final disposal to KHA. The waste has to be weighed and physically handed over to KHA vehicle at specified collection points within the Hospital campus and at given time.
- b. KRISHNA HOSPITAL shall purchase colour coded bags with Barcode stickers from KHA at prices decided from time to time. The current price list has been made available by KHA.
- c. Bio-medical waste will be accepted in bar coded bags supplied by KHA. KHA will not accept any loose waste or waste packed in bags without bar codes. However if the prices of colour coded bags supplied by KSA are higher than the normal market price, Hospital is free to purchase colour coded bags from the open market with prior intimation to KHA. KHA will not accept food waste, coconuts, medicine wrappers or any kind of general waste for the purposes of disposal.

3. Authorisation is valid for a period from **29/11/2016** to **28/11/2021**

4. The authorisation is subject to the conditions stated below and such conditions may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

Terms and conditions of authorisation

- The authorisation shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 and the rules made thereunder.
- The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
- Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
- It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the concerned State Pollution Control Board to close down the operations.
- An application for renewal of an authorisation shall be made in form no. 4 before the twenty days of expiry of existing authorisation as per the procedure laid in sub-rule 13 rule 13.
- The authorisation shall cease to be valid in case of expiry of the validity of suspension of any of the existing consents under Water (Prevention & Control of pollution) Act 1986. Authorization under the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016, issued by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) and shall remain invalid till consent (SI) authorization are obtained.
- The Recycler or Dismantler of the E-Waste shall submit copies of valid Consents & Authorization also to the auctioneers/sellers at the time of each procurement.




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8. The Recycler or Dismantler of the E-Waste shall be responsible to ensure that quantity of the E-Waste (E) procured each time is updated in this Pass-Book by authorized seller / auctioneer / collection center / bulk consumer / producer of the E-Waste.
9. The authorized recycler / dismantler of the E-Waste shall follow guidelines for implementation of the E-Waste (M) Rules, 2016 published by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
10. The recycler / dismantler shall not rent/lend/transfer this registration certificate.
11. Any change in the dismantling/recycling technology, disposal facility & equipment as given in the application only to be carried out with prior permission of MPCEB.
12. The unit should carry out stack emission & ambient quality (AAQ) monitoring of for SPH, RSPM, SO₂, NO_x & monitoring reports should be submitted by the unit to the MPCEB, as per consent conditions.
13. At the time of submission of the application for renewal of authorisation, the unit should submit a copy of the "Authorisation and passbook" along with details of the quantity of E-Waste recycled / E-Waste dismantled / mode of disposal of Hazardous waste generated during validity period of authorisation & statement showing point wise compliance status of above conditions.
14. The transportation of E-Waste shall be carried out as per the manifest system whereby the transporter shall be required to carry a document (3 copies) prepared by the sender, giving the details as per form no. 6 under the provisions of rule 19 of the E-Waste (M) Rules 2016.
15. The Maharashtra Pollution Control Board may cancel or suspend a registration granted under the E-Waste (M) Rules, 2016, if it has reasons to believe that authorised recycler / dismantler has failed to comply with any of the conditions of authorisation, or with any provisions for E-Waste(M) Rules, 2016 or rules made there under or conditions specified in the authorisation.

16. Responsibilities of the Dismantler:-

- a. Every dismantler shall obtain authorization from the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in accordance with the procedure under sub-rule 3 of rule 13 of the E-Waste Rules, 2016.
- b. Every dismantler shall ensure that no damage is caused to the environment during storage & transportation of E-waste.
- c. Every dismantler shall ensure that dismantling processes do not have adverse effect on the health & the environment.
- d. Every dismantler shall ensure that the facility & dismantling processes are in accordance with the standards or guidelines published by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
- e. Ensure that dismantled e-waste are segregated & sent to the registered recycling facilities for recovery of materials.
- f. Ensure that non-recyclable / non-recoverable components are sent to authorized treatment storage & disposal facilities.



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- B. Maintain record of E-Waste collected, dismantled and sent to authorized recycler in Form - 2 and make such records available for scrutiny by Central Pollution Control Board or Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
- 3. File annual return in Form 3, to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board on or before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.
- 4. Shall not process any e-waste for recovery or refining of materials, unless he is registered with Maharashtra Pollution Control Board as a recycler for refining and recovery of materials.

17. Responsibilities of the Recycler:-

- a. Every recycler shall obtain authorization from the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in accordance with the procedure under sub-rule 3 of rule 13 of the E-Waste Rules, 2016
- b. Every recycler shall ensure that no damage is caused to the environment during storage & transportation of E-waste.
- c. Every recycler shall ensure that dismantling processes do not have adverse effect on the health & the environment.
- d. Every recycler shall ensure that the facility & dismantling processes are in accordance with the standards or guidelines published by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
- e. Ensure that non-recyclable / non-recoverable components are sent to authorized treatment storage & disposal facilities.
- f. Maintain record of E-Waste collected, dismantled, recycled in Form - 2 and make such records available for scrutiny by Central Pollution Control Board or Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
- g. File annual return in Form 3, to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board on or before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.
- h. Not process any e-waste for recovery or refining of materials, unless he is registered with Maharashtra Pollution Control Board as a recycler for refining and recovery of materials.

18. Additional conditions: -----





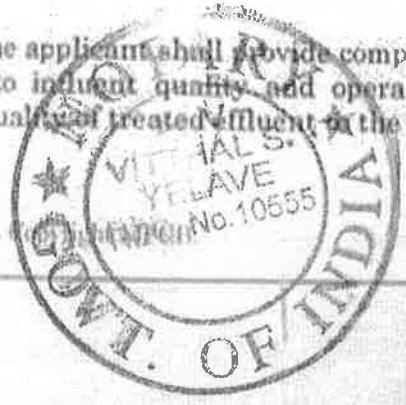
