Dr. Rajendra C. Doijad, Dean, Krishna Institute of Pharmacy, KIMSDU, Karad, took an initiative to arrange 10 days national level Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Industry Pharmacy I, from 20 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ November 2019 to 29th November 2019.

This FDP was special and prestigious as it was organized by Institute of Chemical Technology (ICT), Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Technology, Mumbai, and arranged at Krishna Institute of Pharmacy, KIMSDU, Karad, under auspices of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT)

This FDP was sanctioned by Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), initiated by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India.

The key objectives of this FDP were to update the industrial knowledge and to provide the current perspectives on industrial pharmacy to Pharma faculty members.

For this FDP, Dr. R. C. Doijad (KIP, Karad) and Dr. Vikas Telvekar (ICT, Mumbai) have invited many resource persons and speakers from different reputed Pharma industrics as well as universities.

Moreover, Mr. V. L. Hambar, Ex-Deputy Drugs ${ }^{\text {Controller, Govt. of }}$ Karnataka, Bengaluru, was invited as a keynote speaker for this FDP.
