Student	
Please upload online lectures on SAAKI so that we could cover whatever we miss due to signal issues	Both online as well as offline lectures were uploaded on SAAKI platform, including PPTs with voiceover narration
Career guidance could be more focused	Seminars were conducted by staff regarding career guidance. Topic was included in internship orientation programs. Alumni were invited for motivational talk and guidance.
Rapid revision of theory and practical classes which have been conducted during lockdown period for the entire exam going students.	As per seniority, both UG and PG students were intimated to attend the classes in coordination with the staff in-charge. This was implemented by giving official order to all the subject coordinators and dealt with fast track process before examination. Department-wise WhatsApp groups were formed for easy and rapid communication.
Faculty-student interaction may be enhanced	Learning Management System through interactive activities which enables mutual interaction between faculty and student was encouraged. During lockdown, communication was established through batch-wise / department-wise WhatsApp groups and opinion / feedback was encouraged regarding online lectures
Increase the laboratory facilities	New and adequate laboratory equipment have been procured and upgraded. Frequent review was encouraged and procurement was fast-tracked.

It is also being implemented immediately into hospital clinical practice, like for example establishing designated COVID hospital with dedicated in-house testing facility, introducing cost-effective N95 mask, PPE kit, etc.

Option of electives should be widely disseminated	Electives have been introduced in Faculty of Pharmacy and Allied Sciences. The same is also being considered / introduced for other faculties
