

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

ORDER.

WHEREAS in order to prohibit effect of Corona Virus (Covid -19) in the State, the Government has enacted Anti Epidemic Act, 1897 from 13th March, 2020 and as per the provisions of Parts 2, 3 and 4, notification is issued.

WHEREAS, in view of Section 25 of the Disaster

Management Act, 2005 District Tribunal for Disaster Management is established, and as per its sub-section 2(a) the Collector and the District Magistrate is the designated President of the said tribunal.

AND WHEREAS, patients are found affected from Corona virus contact at international level and in the country. Therefore, considering the possibility of spreading its contact, in order to control it immediately, it is necessary to make suitable solution to prohibit it by not allowing more virus contact.

THEREFORE, I, Shekhar Sinha, President, District Disaster Management Tribunal and District Collector, Satara pass order that - by way of prohibitory solution on Corona virus, in case of emergency service, the institution by name Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, District Satara is authorized to treat suspected Corona -19 patients, till further orders. And Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences is declared as Dedicated Covid Hospital.

For that purposes, in your hospital you should prepare discordance room of 200 with well arranged cots and 40 cots ICU room alongwith necessary arrangement of ventilators and other aspects be made. Also all the doctors and employees related with health be provided with the training in respect of Corona. Also in the hospital well arranged discordance room is to be made and there preparation be made for obtaining Throat Swab. This order is to be implemented immediately.







VILLAGE KHUBI

Geographical Location:

Khubi village is located in Karad Tehsil of Satara district in Maharashtra, India. It is situated 20km away from sub-district headquarter Karad and 87km away from district headquarter Satara. The total geographical area of village is 233.95 hectares. Karad is nearest town to Khubi which is approximately 20km away. As per 2009 stats, the village is also a gram panchayat. It is a medium size village located in Karad of Satara district, Maharashtra with total 337 families residing. The village has a population of 1690 of which 887 are males while 803 are females as per Population Census 2011.

Demography:

In the village population of children with age 0-6 is 170 which makes up 10.06 % of total population of village. Average Sex Ratio is 905 which is lower than Maharashtra state average of 929. Child Sex Ratio as per census is 789, lower than Maharashtra average of 894.

Khubi village has higher literacy rate compared to Maharashtra. In 2011, literacy rate was 85.72 % compared to 82.34 % of Maharashtra. Male literacy stands at 91.54 % while female literacy rate was 79.40 %. Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 17.28 % of total population. The village currently doesn't have any Schedule Tribe (ST) population.

Status

In the village out of total population, 671 were engaged in work activities. 94.49 % of workers describe their work as Main Work (Employment or Earning more than 6 Months) while 5.51 % were involved in Marginal activity providing livelihood for less than 6 months. Of 671 workers engaged in Main Work, 307 were cultivators (owner or co-owner) while 103 were Agricultural labourer.

As per constitution of India and PanchyatiRaaj Act, Khubi village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is elected representative of village.

Criteria for Selection:

The criteria for selecting the village is its inability to access government sponsored development/welfare programmes etc.

- 1. Lack of Government Hospital (PHC/Sub centre), Private Hospital, Pharmacy.
- 2. The nearest Public Health Centre is situated 8 km away at Rethare.
- 3. The village is surrounded by river on one side, leaving only one way access with poor road transport facility.

Goal & Objective:

Goal of rural development programs aims at improvement in their livelihood in a equitable and sustainable manner both Socially, Environmentally and Health through better access to facilities and services.

Objectives of Village Adoption Scheme :

- 1. To provide and strengthen Health care facilities rural communities.
- 2. Ultimate objective being improvement in quality of life.
- 3. To facilitate empowerment of people for income generation, business and related factors for increase in agricultural production.

Process for adoption of village:

Director, Extension Activities, KIMSDU Karad put up a proposal for adoption of village Khubi (Dattak Gram Yojana) which was approved by the University Board of Manageemnt and subsequently approved by Gram Sabha on 2nd October 2015. Following objectives were put up for appraisal for development of village and were approved for joint action program.

- 1. To serve the community by organizing need based programs including Agriculture development.
- 2. To focus on Health program with emphasis on Cleanliness, Sanitation and Preventive aspects of Health Care by awareness campaign.
- 3. Special focus will be on women population and children for Maternal and Reproductive Child Health program including family welfare, Women empowerment and income generation activities.
- 4. To create awareness about development of civic infrastructure
- 5. To provide guidance to improve economic status
- 6. To bring opportunities to increase employment
- 7. To provide access to health, education & awareness

It was resolved that programs will be carried out by village community with support and guidance from institutional initiatives.

Village adoption involves following things-:

- 1. To inspire the rural communities to plan, mobilize forces and resources for sustainable development in the field of hygiene, agricultural development and village
- 2. To empower marginalized and vulnerable groups in the village particularly the elderly, the women, the youth, weaker sections, and the children of the community.
- 3. To build partnerships and networking/tie ups with various agencies (NSS units, NGOs, industries, Public and Private Sector,) and industries working in and around the village/district for development of the village.

HIV/AIDS Awareness Program:

In year 2015-16, individual house hold toilet were found to be available in 272 out of 372 house holds. Currently all house hold have constructed toilets. KIMS has helped out in reviving the old blocked toilets so as to make them usable.



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
Speciality Health Camps:

Specialties like Dental and Physio need specific arrangements for space, light, water connection etc. along with publicity and proper information to public eg. Dental faculty planned for oral hygiene, Dental care and treatment, prevention of oral cancer Physiotherapy conducted Exercises, mobility exercise, rehabilitation etc. Nursing college conducted Community Health awareness for Maternal Child Health program.



Pediatric Health Check:

Children from Balwadi, Anganwadi are provided Health check up including Height, Weight for identifying malnutrition and are offered nutrition supplements and parental counseling.



Adolescent Girls Education Program :

The Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowerment of Adolescent Girls (RGSEAG) under this scheme activities are conducted in collaboration with ICDS as four per year and the team provides them with interactive sessions, role play, visit to hospital etc.



Promotion of Maternal Health:

Pregnant mothers and their under five year children need special attention for the total period of 9 months of pregnancy, choice of place for delivery and care of new born and infant. This is a collaborative program with government agencies, team form PHC, ASHA and Anganwadi workers etc. Registration of woman for pregnancy is nearly total but it lacks in consistent followup throughout 9 month. the medical team and team from college of nursing conducts promotional program and awareness drive to achieve better maternal health care and its outcome.



School Going Children :

Program initiated for students from std VII onwards along with teachers and parents.

- 5. Training of trainers for Yoga in school and promoting regular Yoga practice for students.




Water ATM installation in Khubi:

It is right of community to get clean drinking water as its also important in maintaining good hygiene as well to prevent water born diseases. Keeping this idea in mind KIMSDU has donated and installed water ATM in Khubi village. It will yield more than 5000-liter clean water everyday and enough for the Khubi village population.

There were 40-45 people present during the program, he felicitated by Sarpanch and other key leader from Village. 


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International Yoga Day:



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1. About Institution Deemed To Be University :

Krishna Charitable Trust, the sponsoring society of Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences "Deemed to be University" was established by philanthropist, social reformer and visionary late Shree Jaywantrao Bhosale.
